Having to fend that off with little damage to our crop, the continuous rain has seen the disease Powdery Mildew raise its ugly head with a vengeance and if I

cannot contain it there will be considerable losses but I am certainly giving it my best shot!

On a much brighter note my new labels will be on our new 2011 Everlasting and our 2011 Chardonnay this week—



they look great.
